Through the <u>K-State 105 initiative</u>, Kansas State University and <u>GO Topeka</u> have opened a new resource hub for Shawnee County entrepreneurs: the Topeka/Shawnee County Business Concierge Office in downtown Topeka. The collaboration also involves <u>NetWork Kansas</u>, <u>Omni</u> <u>Circle Group</u>, <u>Washburn University School of Business</u> and the <u>Washburn Small Business</u> <u>Development Center</u>.

The <u>Business Concierge Office</u>, 715 S. Kansas Ave., officially opened during a Nov. 15 ribbon cutting and will serve as a comprehensive resource hub for Topeka and Shawnee County business owners. It is designed to support entrepreneurs at every stage of their business journeys, offering support to both budding startups and established enterprises.
