




STRATEGIC TALENT INVESTMENTS AND FUNDING INITIATIVES

Over the past year, the Office of the Vice President for Research has hired five faculty through the

Biomanufacturing Training and Education

Initiative, with seven more hires planned by fall 2025. The office has also introduced two new funding opportunities: the **DASH awards**, which provide one-year grants for research and creative work, and **core facility support**, including renovations, equipment, pilot projects, and vivarium costs.

CHAMPIONING FACULTY EXCELLENCE

The OVPR supports faculty research through recognition and incentive programs like the **Roots** of Research Faculty Honor Program and Faculty Features in the Research Weekly newsletter. The new Posters, Pinot, and Partnerships event series promotes interdisciplinary collaboration. These initiatives foster research excellence and ensure faculty receive support and recognition for their contributions.
