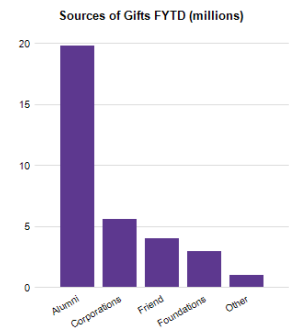

Graduate School Announcements

During the 2024–2025 academic year, the Graduate School will collaborate with six graduate programs to pilot our Enhanced APRR process. This expanded process retains the core elements of the current APRR while strategically addressing recruitment, admissions, enrollment, retention and additional program factors. The Graduate School will provide comprehensive program data and a full market analysis to support strategic planning, resulting in a three-year action plan with annual measures to track meaningful progress.

We are pleased to announce that nine graduate programs have been invited by the Center for Academic Innovation to submit full proposals for funding starting in fall 2025. These programs were selected from 37 executive summary proposals, and we look forward to partnering with them as they continue to innovate at Kansas State University's Graduate School.
