 - For our cultural competency activity on Thursday, we will list various identities around the room (ex: race, ethnicity, gender, sex, sexual orientation, etc.) and then I will ask questions for people to move to the answer that fits them best. I'll have 1-3 people share any thoughts they might have regarding the question (aiming for everyone to talk once and only a few, if any, people to share out twice) The questions I have are:
 1. What part of your identity do you think people first notice about you?
 2. What part of people's identities do you notice first?
 3. What part of your identity do you feel oppression for most often?
 4. What part of your identity do you receive privilege for most often?
 5. What part of your identity do you see having the most effect on your interactions with co-workers/peers?
 6. What part of your identity do you see having the most effect on your interactions with students?
 7. What part of students' identities do you see most often see effecting their interactions with you?
 8. What part of your identity is the most important to you/are you most proud of?
