However, the BA in English (Teacher Licensure Track) in conjunction with the BS in Secondary Education will qualify them to earn licensure. Alternately, student may obtain only the BS in Secondary Education (specializing in English-EDENG) to earn licensure. English majors desiring licensure should consult with their advisors about the best method of completing their degree.
