**Friedmann Exception**

**BY:** Kansas State University Faculty Senate

**WHEREAS,** Mr. Roger Friedmann has been an invaluable instructor and colleague of the English department during the extraordinary duration of thirty-six years of service at Kansas State University, and

**WHEREAS,** Mr. Friedmann has regularly taught overloads, mentored thousands of students, served on numerous committees, and supported the English Department and university tirelessly throughout his long career, and

**WHEREAS,** Over the course of his career, Roger has been recognized by the department for his dedication to his students and the university, and

**WHEREAS,** A conflict exists between the K-State Dependent/Spouse Grant benefit and Mr. Friedmann’s specific needs under that benefit, and

**WHEREAS,** The English Department Head and twenty-seven English faculty have voiced a request on Mr. Friedmann’s behalf that an exception be made to the eligibility requirements.
