Requirements

Undergraduate

- ✓ 3.0 GPA
- ✓ Talk with advisor

- ✓ Statement of objectives designating desired area of specialization, summarizing academic and/or professional experience, and identifying professional goals
- ✓ Current resume
- ✓ Two letters of recommendation
- ✓ Official transcripts for all college coursework
