Who US citizens. 3.2 or higher GPA. Pursuing a graduate in International Affairs or

another area of study relevant to the work of the U.S. Foreign Service.

When Graduating seniors (or recent graduates) who plan to enter graduate study in the

following year.

Selection Criteria Community, academic, extracurricular, and leadership activities will be considered

during the selection process. Students from underrepresented groups are encouraged

to apply. Financial need is also considered. Finalists interview in D.C.

Application Background/resume information. Essays regarding career interest in the Foreign

Service (600 words) and regarding financial need (400 words). Two letters of reference with a leadership or academic focus respectively. Proof of citizenship.

GRE/GMAT scores. Transcripts. Financial aid information.

undergraduate students, which funds summer coursework and supplemental opportunities for undergraduates students (held at Howard University).
