

# Schwarzman Scholars

---

<b>Purpose</b>	To give outstanding students the opportunity to develop their leadership skills and professional networks, while achieving significant exposure to China, through a one-year graduate program at Tsinghua University in Beijing.
<b>Award</b>	
<i>Tenable</i>	Students will live and study together at Schwarzman College within Tsinghua, a new facility constructed for the program. All classes will be taught in English. Students will earn a Masters in Global Affairs, specializing among three different tracks: <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1) Public Policy</li><li>2) Economics and Business</li><li>3) International Studies</li></ol> Can individualize focus within the three options. All scholars also complete a core curriculum (see website for specifics).
<i>Number &amp; Amount</i>	Up to 200 students. Funding is comprehensive and generous. Includes a living stipend and travel expenses.
<i>Duration</i>	One full year.
<b>Eligibility</b>	
<i>Who</i>	Between 18 and 28 (on June 30 of the next year). No citizenship restrictions. English proficiency required. 20% of scholars from China, Hong Kong, Macau and Taiwan. 40% U.S. 40% all other countries.
<i>When</i>	Must successfully complete undergraduate degree prior to enrollment.
<i>Selection Criteria</i>	High academic aptitude and intellectual ability. Leadership potential and entrepreneurial spirit. Ability to anticipate paradigm changes. Exemplary character, and desire to understand other cultures and perspectives.
<b>Campus Deadline</b>	Not necessarily but notify Ms. Powers ASAP of your intent to apply.
<b>Deadline</b>	Spring for students from China, Taiwan, Hong Kong and Macao. September for other applicants.
<b>Application</b>	Apply online. Application form. 100-word bio. Leadership essay. Personal statement. Current resume or CV. Three letters of recommendation. Transcripts. Video introduction (optional).
