STUDENTS WILL BE ABLE TO UNDERSTAND THE FORCES THAT DRIVE PUBLIC OPINION, WHY THE PROCESS VARIES WITHIN THE POPULATION, WHY PEOPLE CHOOSE TO ENGAGE (OR NOT) IN POLITICS, AND WHAT FACTORS INFLUENCE ELECTORAL DECISIONS.
