Per KBOR Policy {Chapter 2}, when constructing its academic calendar, each institution shall:

- (1) provide for an academic year that minimally consists of two sixteen-week semesters (one Fall semester and one Spring semester);
- (2) offer no fewer than 146 instructional days plus five final exam days each Fall and each Spring semester;

Fall/Spring terms must be NO fewer than 146 instructional days (73 days in Fall and 73 days in Spring) plus five final exam days each semester

## K-State Internal Application of Instructional Day Requirement:

16-week semester  $\{16*7 - \text{the Sat/Sun of week 16 (2dys)} = 110 \text{ calendar days}\}$ 

16-week semester instructional days (M-F only) {16\*5 = 80 instructional/business days available}

Fall: 73 instructional days + 5 exam days = minimum 78 days

Spring: 73 instructional days + 5 exam days = minimum 78 days

Summer: current full session is 12 weeks  $\{12*7 = 84 \text{ calendar days}\}\$  with total of 58-60 instructional days minimum 12-week semester instructional days (M-F only)  $\{12*5 = 60 \text{ calendar days}\}\$ 

- (3) end the Fall semester before December 31 and begin the Spring semester no earlier than the beginning of the calendar year;
- (4) align spring break as approved by the Board on December 16, 2020; and
- (5) observe the following holidays approved by the Board and other special holidays declared by the Governor:
