

# Clinical Psychology Certificate

The undergraduate certificate in Clinical Psychology is designed to provide a focused track of courses designed to increase the knowledge and skills of individuals interested in the field of clinical psychology. The curriculum provides foundational theoretical and practical coverage of human behavior, mental health, ethics, and current research in the field. It also provides targeted training in assessment, diagnosis, and treatment of mental health disorders. This certificate is intended for students interested in entering graduate or professional school in mental health and/or wanting to work with psychiatric patients after graduation.
