Putnam Hall Constitution considerations:

Article 7 Section D Clause 2, which states that residents running for President must attend 10 meetings prior to elections, was not suspended in a 7-agreed, 0-opposed vote

Article 7 Section A, which states that all candidates must be a current resident of Putnam Hall, was suspended in a 6-agreed; 1-opposed vote.

Article 7 Section D Clause 2, which states that residents running for an HGB position other than president must attend 3 meetings to be considered, was suspended in a 7-agreed; 0-opposed vote.

HGB adjourned to a closed session to discuss a confidential matter involving the elections and, after deliberation, a motion was passed to hold a re-election.

Putnam HGB Re-elections 2009

Due to a belief that the election held on April 1, 2009 was influenced in an unfair manner, the Hall Governing Board has voted to hold a second election. This election is taking place Monday, April 6th and Tuesday, April 7th in the Van Zile Lobby from 4:40pm-6:40pm. It will be run by the chair of the elections committee - Christie Coffman - and a third party observer: a Boyd HGB volunteer who is not running for a Putnam position.
